Dangers of Unbelief

<u>Unbelief</u> is often a <u>subtle</u> danger.

1. Jesus needs to prove Himself again.

When we are <u>testing</u> Jesus, we are not <u>trusting</u> Jesus.

2. We seek a <u>cleaned</u> life more than a <u>changed</u> life.

<u>Salvation</u> is not found in the <u>ordering</u> of our lives; the <u>order</u> of our lives is found in <u>salvation</u>.

3. Our definition of a <u>disciple</u> is found in <u>how</u> we <u>feel</u> and not in <u>what</u> we <u>do</u>.

Discipleship is not knowing what we believe; discipleship is doing what we believe.
