The Problems	The Promises
Self-Minded	Spirit-Minded
Hostile to God	Humble before God
By unrighteousness, cannot please God	By Christ's righteousness, pleasing to God
Bound to Sin	Nojudgment
Bound to Death	Alive
Spirit of Slavery	Free
Spirit of Fear	Adopted: A Child of God
Heir of Flesh (Self)	Heir of God and Co-heir with Christ
Powerless over sin and wrong	Power to put to death sin and wrong

Stop <u>taking up</u> what Jesus <u>took</u>. Stop <u>putting on</u> what Jesus <u>put off</u>.

Put on <u>victory</u>. Take up <u>power</u>. Put on <u>identity</u>. Take up the <u>promises</u>.

The Spirit-Set Mind:

Lives in <u>conviction</u> without <u>condemnation</u>. Seeks <u>right freely</u> without <u>fear</u>. <u>Powerful</u> over <u>sin</u> without <u>sinful pride</u>. Sees the <u>pleasure</u> of God without <u>performance</u>. Lives like a <u>child</u>, not a <u>slave</u>.
