“So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.” 1 Corinthians 13:13

The greatest is love because love is eternal.

Faith becomes sight. Hope becomes reality. Love lasts forever.

The only way you can give something is if you got something.

“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God and whoever loves has been born of God, and knows God.” 1 John 4:7

Love embraced by God is extended to other people.
